

HELLWEEK - CADET SELECTION

(I)

Hellweek is intended as a follow-up for candidates who have already passed the initial one-day evaluation towards selection.

Candidates will be accommodated in tents.

Date	April 7th - 14th
Time	16h00 Sunday afternoon to 16h00 on the 14th
Duration	Seven days
Venue	Bass Lake Henley on Klip
Evaluation fee	R1500 (which includes meals and drinks for the week)

VERY IMPORTANT

The program must not be under-estimated. Come well prepared.

Only the very toughest will be considered for a Cadetship.

Read the instructions in this website very carefully.

Only candidates selected during the one-day evaluation are proceeding to hellweek

Indemnification forms signed for the one-day evaluation will be used for hellweek so the candidates do not have to endorse an additional indemnification.

Strictly military discipline will be enforced during the week, as also it will be in future during Cadetship.

Candidates will report with Nr 2 hair-cuts.

GENERAL

1 *Evaluation fee - R1, 500*

Contact Capt Coertzen for the arrangements on payment of the fee.

Contact him in the whatsapp group.

The fee needs to be paid well in advance. Do this as soon as possible.

It covers all meals and drinks for the week.

2 *Transport to the venue*

Each candidate is fully responsible for transport arrangements. FIRE OPS SA does not take any responsibility for transportation arrangements.

Candidates must be at the mustering point before 16h00 on Sunday April 7th.

Be precise. Be in time.

Anyone not being at the gate by this time will be turned away.

Three x PT shorts

Three x T-shirts

Running shoes

Swimming trunks & Towels

Shaving gear

A pair of well-worn boots and thick socks may come in handy

If you do have personal flippers, diving suits, snorkels or life jackets, bring it along.
